



Dartford Festival 2017 Admission Policy

- Dartford Borough Council reserves the right, with reasonable cause, to refuse entry to the Festival or Central Park, of any person, group, body or organisation or evict any person, group, body or organisation from the Festival or Central Park and the Council's decision to do so shall be final.
- Dartford Borough Council shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage suffered by any person at the Festival or Central Park where such loss, injury or damage was occasioned by conduct on the part of that person or by failure to take proper and reasonable care whether on the part of the person who suffered such loss, injury or damage or such other person who was at the relevant time, responsible for that person.
- There will be a random search on admission policy in operation. It is a condition of entry that you will submit to any reasonable search request.
- There is a 'zero tolerance' for illegal substances and legal highs at the Festival. Any person in possession of such substances will be denied entry and/or removed from the Festival, and the Police will be called to attend.
- The following items are not permitted on the Festival site: portable laser equipment and pens, unauthorised professional film or video equipment, professional audio recording equipment, portable barbecues, air horns, spray cans, fireworks and flares, sky lanterns or anything that we consider could be used as a weapon.
- The use of drones/UAV is strictly prohibited.
- No animals allowed on the site, with the exception of registered assistance dogs.
- You will be permitted to bring into the Festival site a reasonable amount of alcohol for your personal consumption.
- Fold up chairs and blankets are permitted. Gazebos and large parasol type umbrellas are not permitted as they restrict other Festival goers' views.
- CCTV will be operating throughout the Festival site.
- The Event operates a 'Challenge 25' system at the bars, so if you are lucky to look younger than 25, please bring I.D.
- The distribution of literature e.g. flyers/leaflets without the consent of Dartford Borough Council is strictly prohibited and the Council reserves the right to confiscate the literature.
- Visitors consent to being photographed, filmed and recorded as visitors to the Festival and consent to the use any such film, image or recording at the discretion of Dartford Borough Council.
- Warning-Excessive exposure to loud music may cause damage to your hearing. Please note that pyrotechnics, lasers, smoke machines, strobe lighting or other special effects may take place during some performances.
- The billed music and attractions line-up and times may be subject to change at any time without notice.
