**Subject:** NI 35 – Building Resilience to Violent Extremism

**Purpose and summary of report:**

To present Members of the LSP with the outturn for NI 35 for Dartford and Gravesham.

**Recommendations:**

1. Members of the LSP review the information provided for NI 35 and endorse the outturn that has been reported for 2009-10.

**1. Introduction**

- 1.1 NI 35 measures the processes that have been put in place to build resilience in the area to extremism. The indicator is based on achieving scores against four different criterion:
  - 1.1.1 Understanding of, and engagement with, Muslim communities
  - 1.1.2 Knowledge and understanding of the drivers and causes of violent extremism and the Prevent objectives
  - 1.1.3 Development of a risk-based preventing violent extremism action plan, in support of the delivery of the Prevent objectives
  - 1.1.4 Development of a risk-based preventing violent extremism action plan, in support of the delivery of the Prevent objectives

**2. Calculating the Outturn 2009-10**

- 2.1 In order to determine the level at which both Dartford and Gravesham are at for 2009-10, the Strategic Manager (Community Safety) at Gravesham Borough council undertook the initial review of both areas against the criteria (see appendix one).

- 2.2 Upon completion of the initial assessment this has been reviewed and updated in conjunction with other partners including Police colleagues from Special Branch and colleagues from Dartford Borough Council.
- 2.3 On this basis the outturn for this indicator has been recorded as '3'.
- 2.4 Targets for future years have been set to strive to achieve a '4'.
- 2.5 The definition of the indicator states that the indicator must be reported on by the Local Strategic Partnership. The deadline for submitting the data was 31 May 2010 and therefore the data has already been submitted; the self-assessment is being presented to the LSP for further ratification.
