NOTICE is hereby given that the KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, has made the above named Order, acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of which would change the current Single Yellow Lines to Double Yellow Lines (DYL's) (No waiting at any time) restriction in the following road:-

West Hill, Dartford

a) The south side from a point 14 metres east of its junction with Royal Mail access road to a point 15 metres west of the western boundary of No. 48.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Kent County Council as traffic authority intends to make the Order referred to above and as shown on the drawing accompanying this document for the following reasons :-

As part of the Dartford Town Centre improvements and changes to bus services in Market Street, a new temporary bus stop has been provided on the south side of West Hill outside the Royal Mail Sorting Office. As a result, due to the need to ensure the safety of bus customers boarding and alighting at the temporary bus stop, it is proposed to replace the existing time limited waiting restriction with a 'no waiting at any time' restriction. Increasing the restriction at this location will stop vehicles parking at the bus stop and enable buses to access the bus stop hereby reducing the potential conflict between vehicles and bus passengers.
