

Right to Buy Additional Information

This form is for use by tenants who wish to claim the right to purchase their home under the Right to Buy scheme.

You could be eligible for a Right to Buy discount if:

- You are a secure council tenant
- ✓ The property is your only or principal home
- You have been a public sector tenant (usually a tenant of a council or a housing association) for at least 3 years
- You don't live in sheltered housing or other housing particularly suitable for elderly or disabled people
- ✓ your tenancy of an elderly persons dwelling commenced when you were under the age of 60
- ✓ Your home is not due to be demolished
- ✓ You don't have any legal problems with debt
- ✓ You don't have any outstanding possession orders

If you can answer 'yes' to these statements, you are probably eligible to apply for the Right to Buy your property but Dartford Borough Council will still need to verify the information you provide.

This form is used to consider your eligibility for the Right to Buy. It is used in conjunction with the RTB1 Application Form. When you have completed both of these forms, take them or send them by recorded delivery to Dartford Borough Council. If you take them by hand, ask for a receipt. Keep a copy of the completed forms yourself.
