- Introduce Disabled Badge Holders Only, maximum stay 3 hours no return within 1 a. hour, at the following location:
  - Broomfield Road, Swanscombe from the common boundary of No.72 & 74, i. east for a distance of 6 metres.
  - Church Road, Swanscombe from the common boundary of No.40 & 42, east ii for a distance of 6 metres.
  - Colney Road, New Town from the common boundary of No.116 & 118 Colney Road, east for a distance of 6 metres. iii iv
    - Henderson Drive, Temple Hill from the common boundary of No.29 & 31 Henderson Drive, south for a distance of 6 metres.
- Revoke Disabled Badge Holders Only, maximum stay 3 hours no return within 1 hour, b. at the following location:
  - Colney Road, New Town from the common boundary of No.78 & 80 west for distance of 6 metres. i ii

Lavinia Road, New Town - from the common boundary of No.24 & 26 Lavinia i. Road, east for a distance of 6 metres.

Introduce Waiting Restrictions Monday to Friday 7am to 10am in the following e location:

Kent Road-Longfield, from the common boundary of No.17 & 19 Kent Road, west for a distance of 5 metres to a point 10 metres east.

- Revoke Limited waiting 2 hours No return within 4 hours or Permit holders L1 Mon-Fri 9.30am-4pm.
  - i. Kent Road-Longfield, from the boundary of Nos. 15/17 in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 10 metres
- Restricted parking ZONE No waiting at any time
  - Extend the existing Restricted parking ZONE within Suffolk Road to cover the i. extent of Bulls Head Yard.
