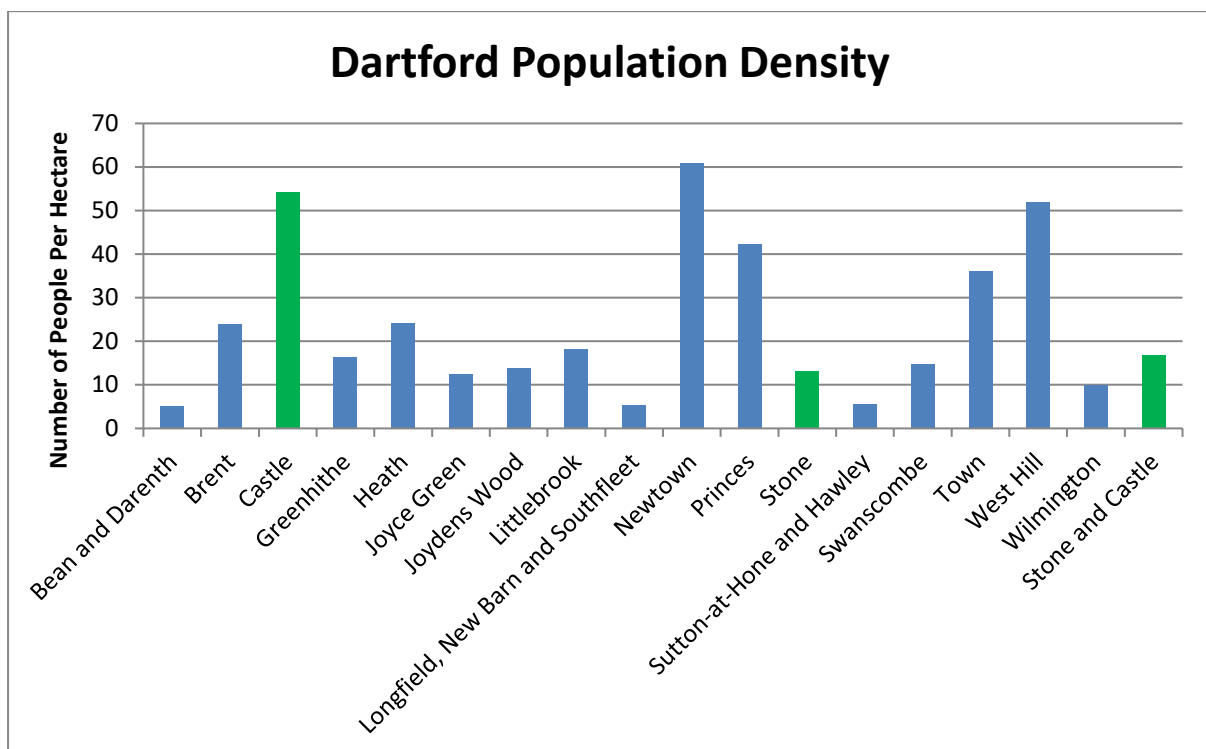

Average Age

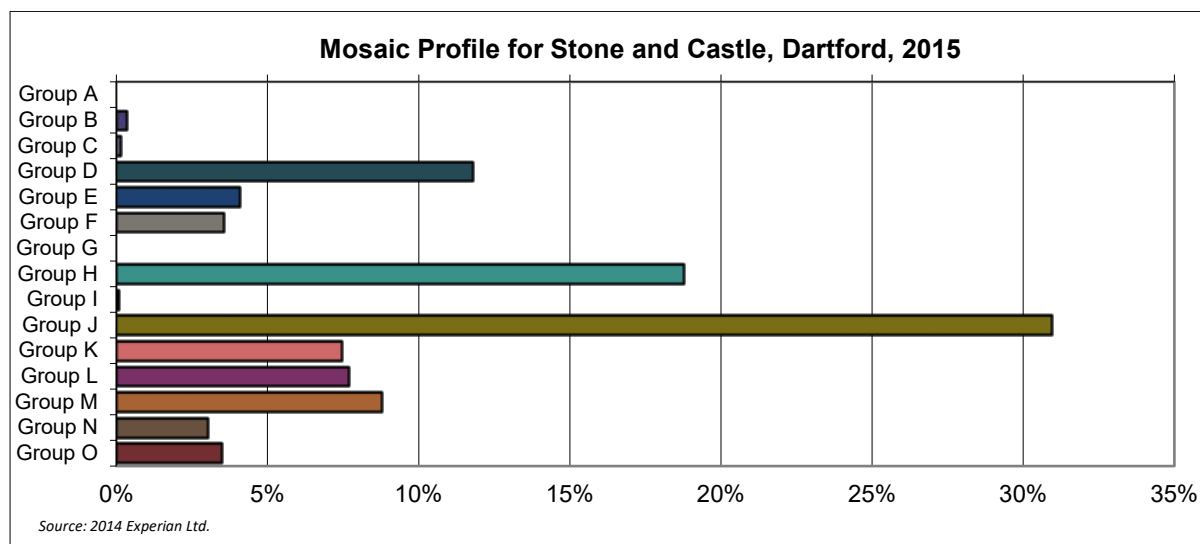


Population Density

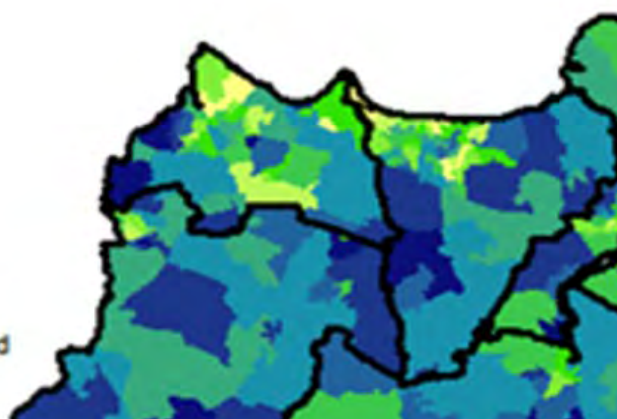
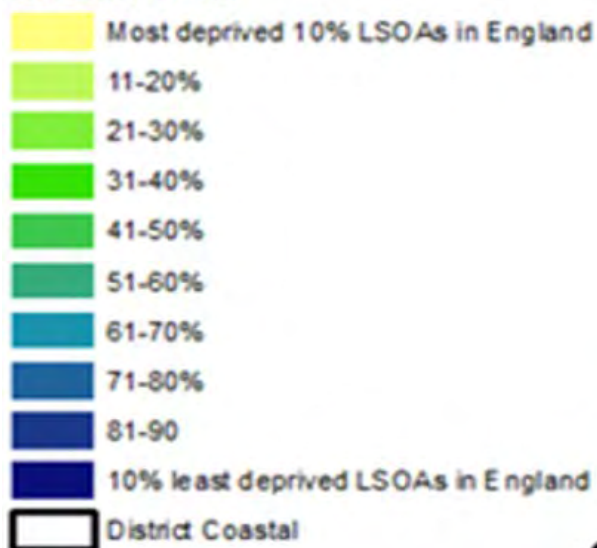
- Country Living - Well off owners in rural locations enjoying the benefits of Country life

Deprivation

Overall IMD - England Position

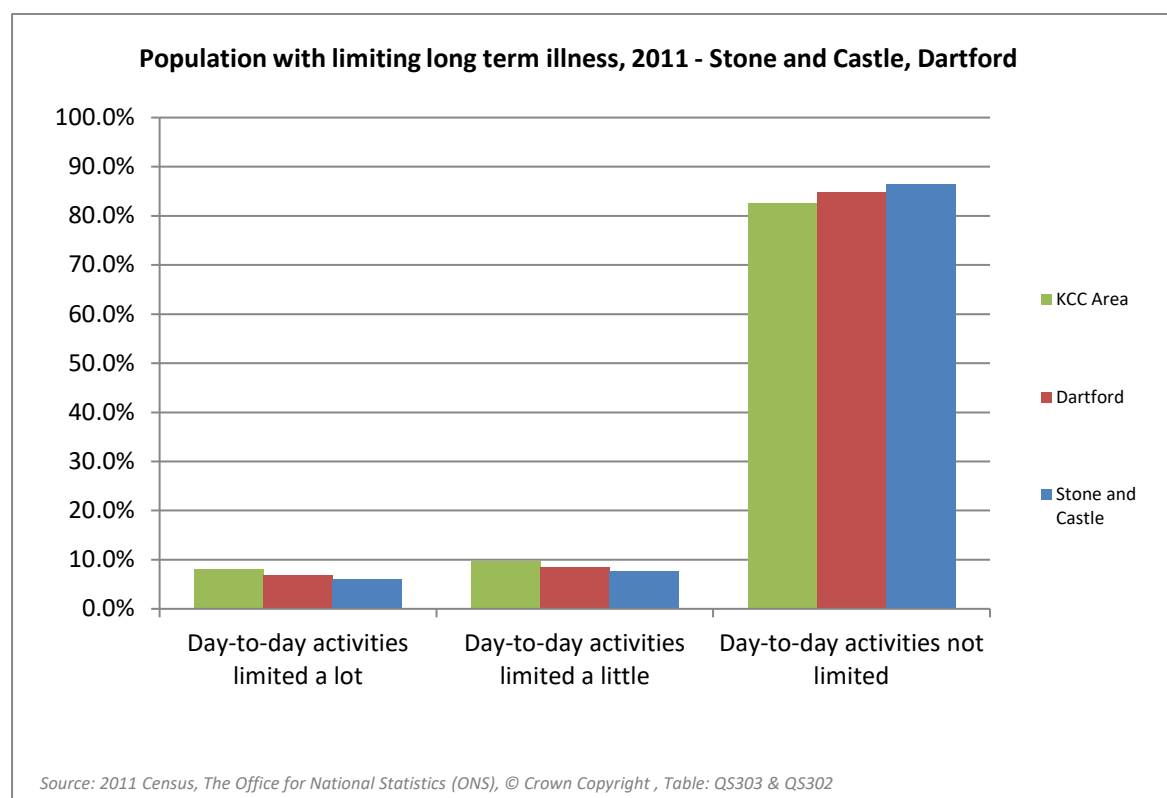
National Rank



Factor-by-factor: within top 20% most deprived in England?

ONS also produce data on individual elements of deprivation, these include: Employment, Health & Disability, Education, Barriers to Housing and Services, Crime, Living Environment, Income Deprivation Affecting Children and Income Deprivation Affecting Elderly. The majority of the factors are not within the top 20% of most deprived. However, the area in the west of the ward does fall into the top 20% most deprived for three of the factors and other parts do have one factor in the top 20%.

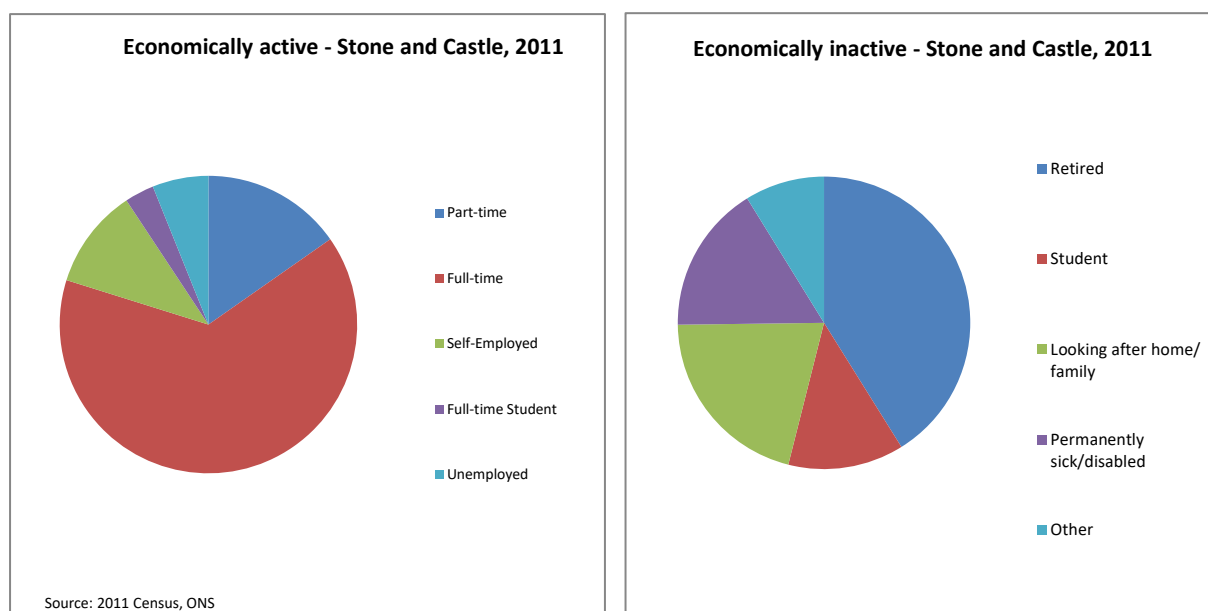

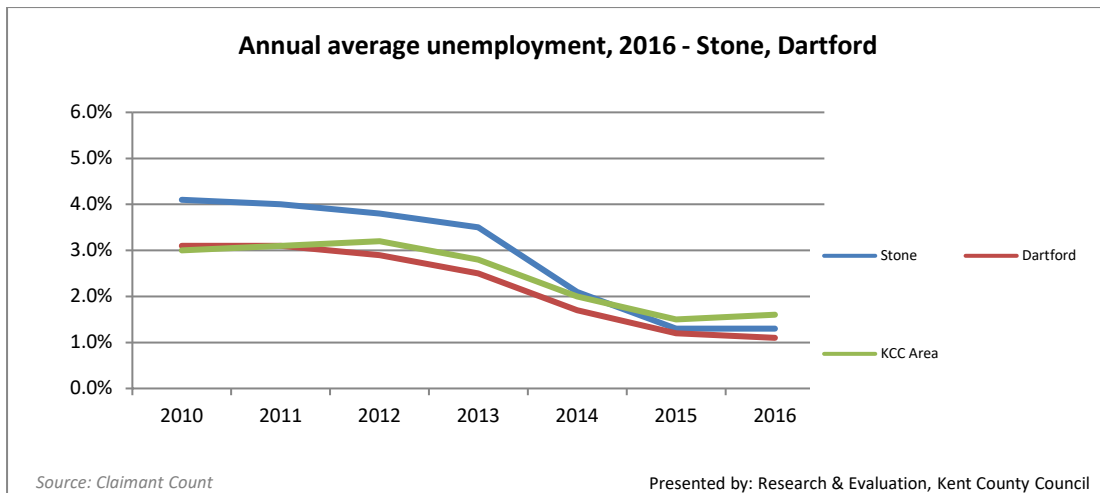

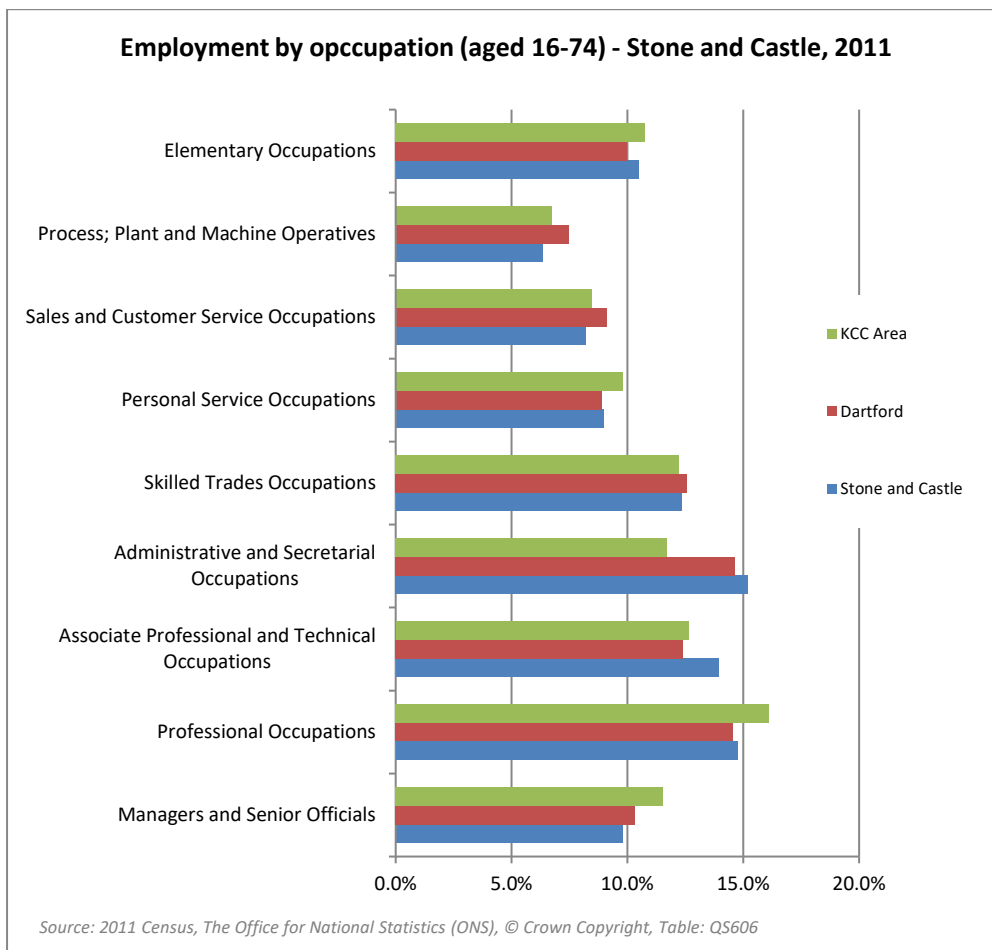
Economic activity



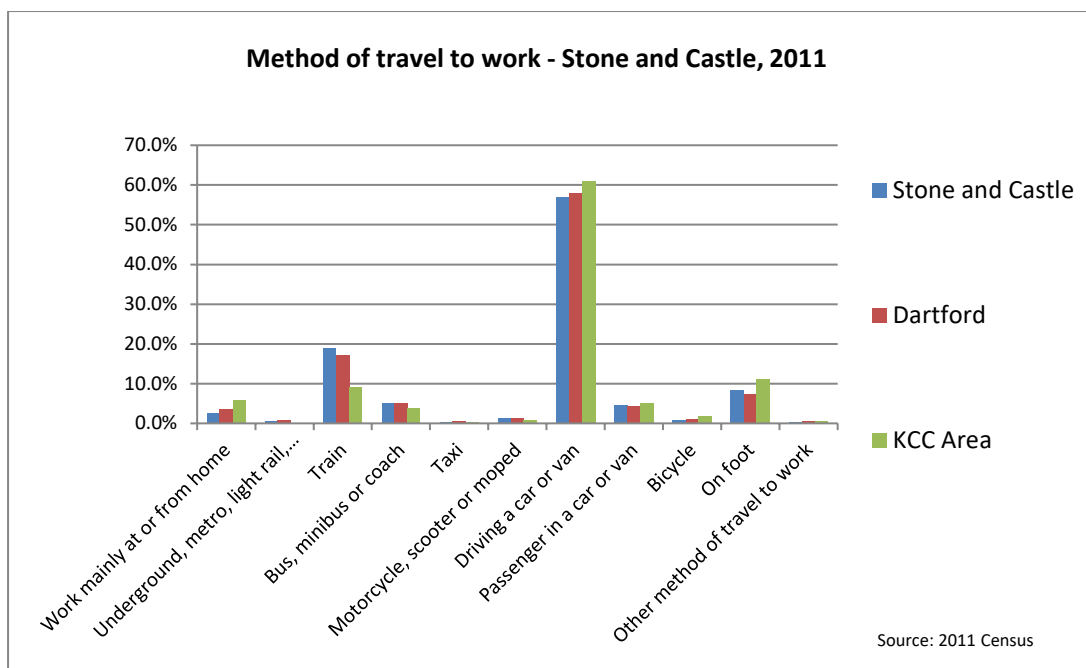
Unemployment



Employment by occupation



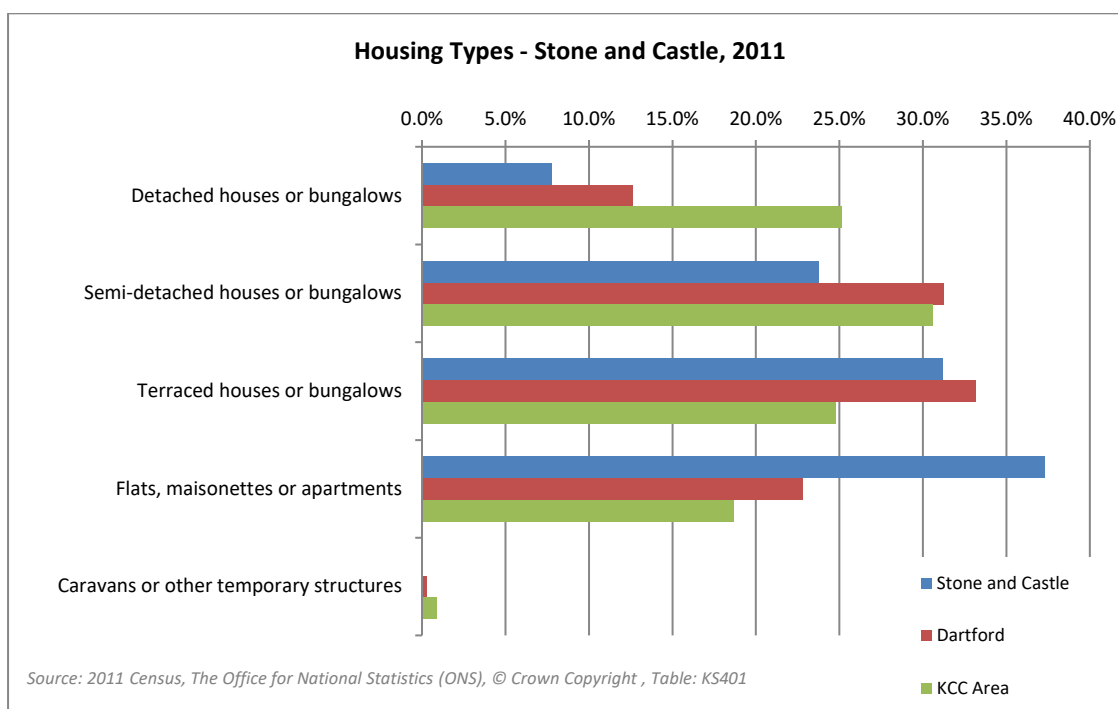

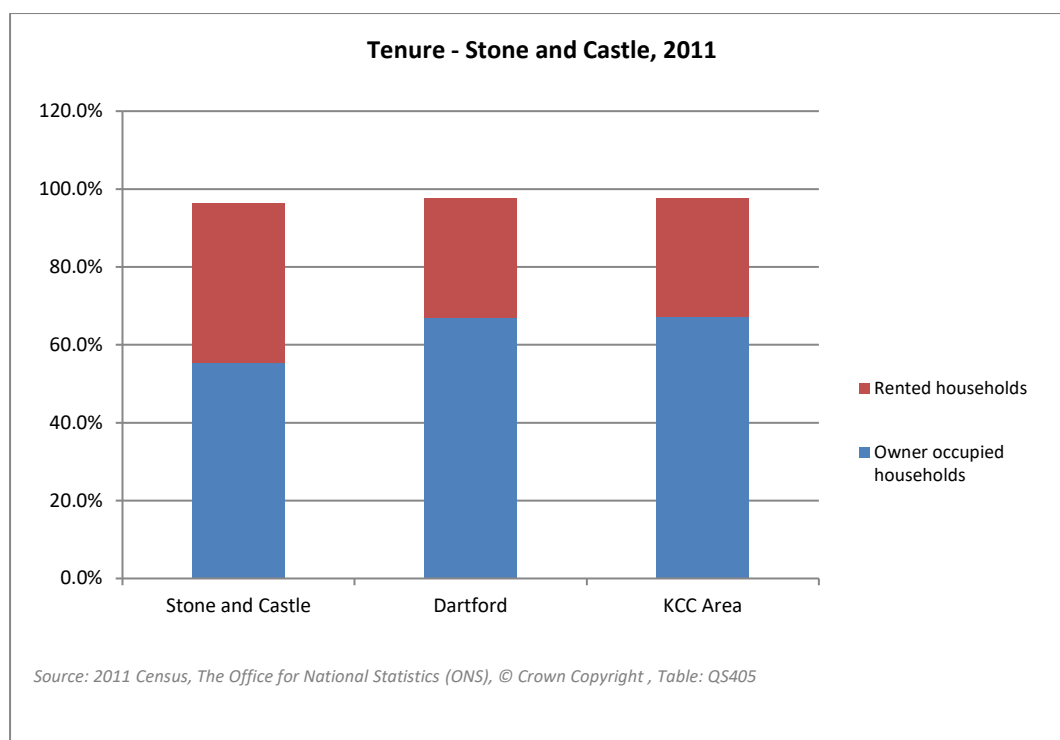

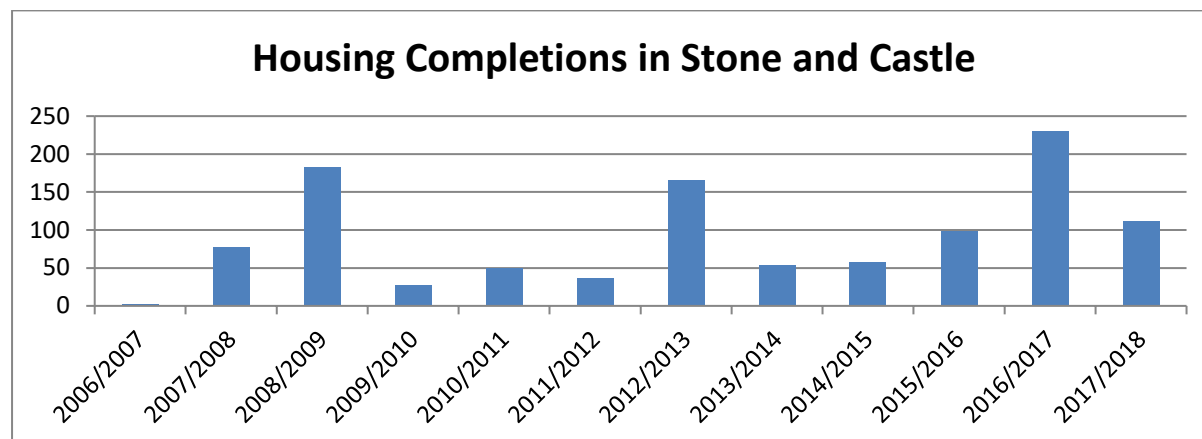

SUMMARY

- Stone and Castle wards collectively has a population that is younger than the Dartford average, with the average age being 34 (compared to the Dartford average of 38 and KCC of 41).
- The area population has increased by 217 per annum (2011-16).
- The ward's primary 'type' of household according to Mosaic research, that has been categorised based on data on expenditure and other personally indicative decisions, are "Retail Hubs" (Educated young people privately renting in urban neighbourhoods) and "Aspiring Homemakers" (Younger households settling down in housing priced within their means), making up nearly 50% of the population in 2015.
- Stone and Castle wards include 36% of jobs in Dartford Borough, particularly due to inclusion of Crossways Business Park and Bluewater.
- Unemployment is slightly higher in the area than the Borough average of 1.1%, but remains low at 1.6%.
- More people in Stone and Castle rent their home than average. There is a relatively even split between owner occupied (55%) and rented (41%).
- A mixture of housing types can be found in Stone and Castle, with 37% of dwellings in Stone and Castle being flats, maisonettes or apartments. 31% is terraced housing and the remaining, 42% are detached and semi-detached houses/bungalows.
- Housing density is low in Stone and high in Castle, compared to the Borough as a whole.
- There has been an average of 89 homes per year completed in this ward over the last 11 years.
- Life expectancy is lower than average for the rest of the Borough. Parts of Stone and Castle are also in the top 20% most deprived with regards to some areas, particularly barriers to housing and services.
