

# Draft Housing Strategy 2025-2028 Consultation

#### **Consultation Overview**

The Housing Strategy sets out the Council's plans on how it intends to deliver its Housing Service to residents over the next three years. The Council is committed to providing genuinely affordable homes for our residents and communities whilst ensuring that our homes in the borough are safe, secure places to live.
